WHAT IS SCRIPS?

SCRIPS is another name for gift cards. Each gift card you purchase has a specific amount of money that the merchant donates to the Eastern Technical High School PTSA. Cards are available for gas, restaurants, clothes, groceries, Amazon and Groupon purchases. Many places you already shop!! Wal-Mart, Sam's Club and Giant Foods are examples of the most popular cards with many places available.

Gift cards make great gifts and can be purchased through this program. A complete list of gift cards is available by going to www.shopwithscrip.com This program is a service to Eastern Tech families. Payment must be made with the order.

WHAT MAKES BUYING SCRIPS SO GREAT??

- *Purchase gas cards for that new driver so they're never without gas.
- *Purchase food cards for your weekly grocery shopping.
- *Purchase restaurant cards and treat the family.
- *Purchase store gift cards and shop for the birthdays and holidays
- *Purchase gift cards now and save them to shop for Valentine's Day!

Buying SCRIPS gift cards supports your normal family buying at no extra cost AND greatly helps your PTSA with little added effort !!

SCRIP Gift Cards Frequently Asked Questions - and Answers!

How does buying gift cards from SCRIPS help Eastern Tech?

When you buy SCRIP gift cards, a percentage is donated from the merchant to Eastern Tech PTSA.

Are SCRIP cards the same as gift cards you can purchase at the store?

Yes! They look the same and can be used in exactly the same way.

Where does the percentage that Eastern Tech earns come from?

The merchant donates a percentage to Eastern Tech. You pay \$25 and get a \$25 gift card. You pay \$10 and get a \$10 gift card. Whatever amount you choose to buy, you get the full face value. **There are NO additional fees.**

How can I buy SCRIPS gift cards?

Return a completed order form (attached) and your cash or check payment in an envelope marked SCRIPS to the PTSA mailbox in the main office.

Why can't I pay with my credit card?

SCRIPS does not accept credit cards, By paying with cash or check, SCRIPS saves on credit card transaction fees and passes the savings on to the Eastern Tech HS PTSA.

When (and how) will I receive my purchased gift cards?

Approximately 1 week after the order deadline, the cards will be placed in an envelope and put in the mailbox of your student's homeroom teacher UNLESS you indicate on your order form not to. In that case, you will be contacted using the information you provide to arrange for pickup.

PLEASE give SCRIPS a try! For the holidays don't waste your gas driving from store to store. Let SCRIPS do the work for you and you will have more time to spend doing the things you enjoy.

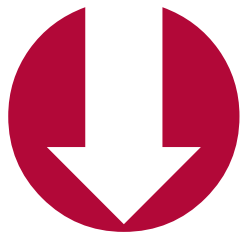

Eastern Technical High School Class of 2016 Essential Information



Class of 2016, Congratulations! Senior year is upon us... This is an exciting time. You and your family are about to share very special experiences that should provide fond memories for years to come. In order to have a smooth final semester of high school, careful examination of some essential information is critical. It will assist you in understanding the expectations that we have for all graduating seniors. Please remember the following:

The last official day of school for seniors is May 27, 2016.

- The Senior Prom is scheduled for Saturday, May 28, 2016.
- Please note: All Baltimore County Policies and Procedures will be in effect at every school function whether on school grounds or at events being held elsewhere. A suspension during senior year MAY prevent participation in important senior year events including commencement ceremonies.
- Attendance at certain Eastern Tech senior events will be **mandatory**. Seniors will not participate in commencement from the stage if they are absent from ANY of the mandatory attendance events that help prepare our graduates for the commencement ceremony.
- Signed parental permission is required for students opting out of graduation activities, due by May 1 to the graduation coordinators.
- All fines and obligations (books, uniforms, dues, and fees) need to be satisfied by **May 13, 2016 by 2:00** or you will not be permitted to participate in commencement exercises on June 9, 2016.
- Senior "Surveys" must be completed in order for graduation tickets to be released to seniors. Senior surveys will be completed during class-time in April when counselors visit senior career major classes.
- Caps and gowns will be distributed at Eastern Tech during the week of senior finals. Seniors will receive their graduation tickets, graduation robes, seating and "line up" assignments at that time. Obligations must be met in order for these items to be distributed.

Graduation Regalia

National Recognition Products was in attendance at Eastern Tech on November 10 and November 11 for cap and gown ordering. The cost for cap and gown was \$9.95. Students were reminded to order and pay for graduation regalia early because NRP (National Recognition Products) will raise the price of the cap and gown after February 3, 2016 to \$30.00.

Senior 100's Night (cancelled—Blizzard of 2016)

Cancelled due to the blizzard of 2016, Senior 100 Night not able to be re-scheduled.

Senior Farewell Assembly

The Senior Farewell Assembly is the opportunity for us to recognize those seniors who have earned scholarships, awards and/or other recognitions. This event is a **mandatory event** to be attended by every senior. Seniors will wear their graduation gowns for this event (graduation caps not required).

- Date : Thursday May 26, 2016
- Time: **9 a.m.** (Seniors must be in line by 7:30 a.m. at Eastern Tech)
- Location: Eastern Technical High School Gym-1 (**un**-air-conditioned)

Only seniors receiving an award or recognition will receive two adult guest tickets in order for parents to attend the Farewell Assembly.

Senior Picnic

Senior Picnic is Friday, May 27, 2016 from 12 noon until 2:00 p.m. Tickets are \$5.00 per student and there will be food, DJ and games. The location of the picnic will be Renaissance Park.

Senior Prom

The Senior Prom is May 28, 2016 from 7 p.m. until 11 p.m., at Boumi Temple followed by the PTSA *After Prom Party*. Prom Ticket prices will be announced at a later date.

Graduation Rehearsal

Wednesday, June 8, 2016, from **8 am until 11 am in the Eastern Tech gym**. Seniors are required to attend this mandatory **commencement practice at Eastern Tech**. Please keep that date and time clear as your attendance at this practice is **mandatory**. You are not expected to wear graduation gowns for practice.

Commencement

Graduates must report to **Towson SECU-arena by 1:30 pm**, on Thursday, June 9, 2016. Commencement begins promptly at 2:30 p.m. There will be handicapped seating and parking available. Additional information will follow concerning specifics about handicapped seating. Please contact graduation coordinators if hearing-impaired (sign language) interpreter is needed

Graduation Tickets

Each graduating senior will be provided **EIGHT** tickets for graduation. These tickets will be distributed when students receive their caps and gowns. **NO additional tickets will be available.**

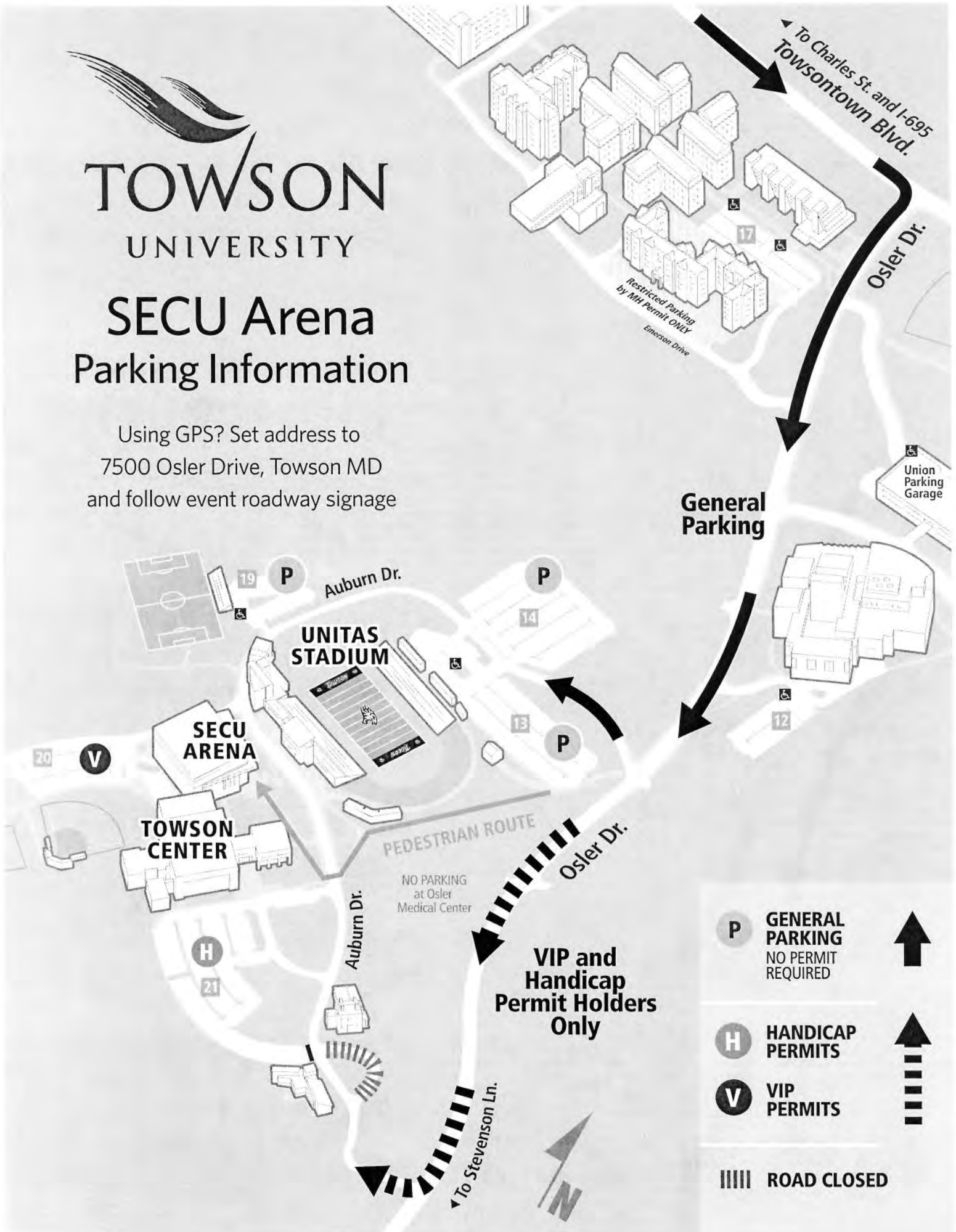

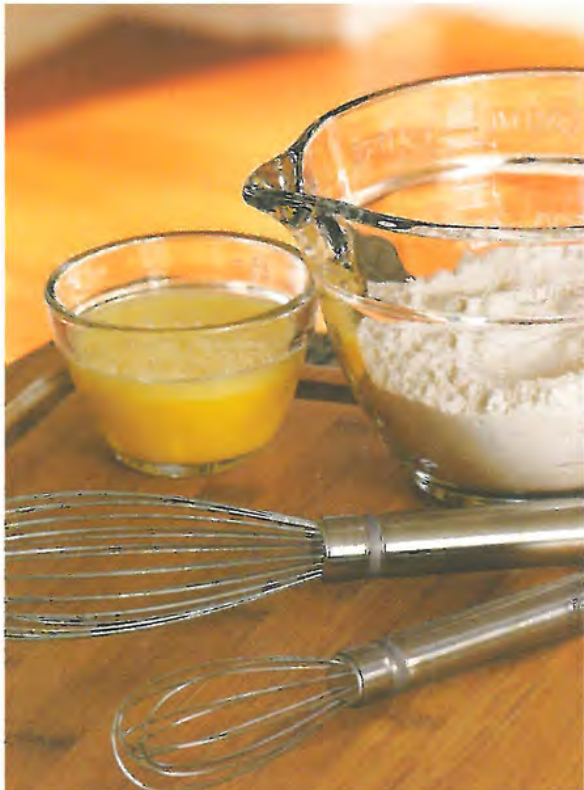
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
