## From the Principal . . .

I hope you are enjoying our somewhat mild winter months (at least so far)! I'd like to share some of the exciting news we're experiencing at Eastern Tech because of the efforts of our terrific students, teachers, and coaches - starting with our "Winter Sports" teams. As you probably know the MPSSAA, the state governing body of high school athletics, ranks high school student/athletes by GPA. Students who earn a 3.0 GPA are placed on the *Baltimore County All Academic Team*. Students who earn a 3.25 GPA earn the *MPSSAA Minds in Motion* designation. The following chart shows our current teams and the number of student/athletes on each team by category. We are very proud of the efforts they make to represent Eastern Tech so well while maintaining strong performance in the classroom. In addition, one of our juniors, **Jen MacDonald** recently won the Baltimore Brain Bee Competition and will continue on to the national competition! Our VEX Robotics Team has been getting "better and better" with each of their competitions. In the most recent one, our team earned 3 Tournament Champions and a Robot Skills Champion.

Our teachers and students are working hard to prepare for our initial experience with the new PARCC assessments. PARCC for English 10 will occur on March 3 and March 4; PARCC for Alg II will occur on March 11. We encourage our students to practice with their teachers and to make sure you are in attendance on test days.

Finally, I'd like to remind our parents of the upcoming community forums in early March 2015 to solicit opinion about recommendations relating to the school system's magnet schools and programs. The proposals are the result of a Magnet Task Force that was charged with examining the county's magnet programs and providing recommendations for the program's future. Those who are unable to attend one of the forums may contribute their viewpoints on an upcoming online survey.
