# *Eastern Tech Science Summer Camp*

Date: **July 28–August 1, 2014** (same as Summer Academy for Success in Mathematics)

Time: **12:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m.**

Where: **Eastern Tech H.S. Room 203**

Cost: **\$25, payable by cash or check made out to Eastern Technical High School**

**You are responsible for your own transportation. Lunch will not be provided, so if you are attending the math camp in the morning, bring a lunch with you to eat between camps.**

High school science can be very different from middle school science. Get a head start by attending the Eastern Tech Science Summer Camp. Lab work is very important in high school science. This camp will give experience with the equipment, calculations, and reporting of lab data used in high school.

- Review how to properly use common science lab equipment and technology
- Graph data using a calculator, a computer with Excel, and by hand
- Review the steps of the scientific method in order to write a formal lab report
- Perform lab activities to apply concepts learned (including on Sea Monkeys)

There will be a limit of forty participants in the camp on a first come, first served basis.

The fee is used to buy supplies for camp, so no refunds will be available unless a student from the waiting list accepts the spot. **Congratulations to the Class of 2014!** We are very proud of their accomplishments during their four years at Eastern Tech. The class of 2014 has a 100% graduation rate. At our recent graduation ceremony we congratulated the class for having earned approximately \$8.7 million dollars in scholarships and grants based on their academic achievements. Congratulations to Coach Jack Meyers and our 2014 Softball Team for winning the Class 2A MD State Championship and to graduating senior Jordan Cargile for being named the Baltimore Sunpapers “Player of the Year” for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year in a row. Jordan will be pitching for the University of Delaware next year.

Special thanks to Donna Murphy and Kim Burton-Regulski for all of their assistance to plan and organize our graduation ceremony and to class sponsors Jenny Pagliarini and Terry Otto for all of their efforts with Senior Prom, graduation, and all of the class business throughout their time with us. When you buy SCRIP gift cards, a percentage is donated from the merchant to Eastern Tech's PTSA.

#### **Are SCRIP cards the same as gift cards you can purchase at the store?**

Yes! They look the same and can be used in exactly the same way. (But **you save time and money** when you buy gift cards through the SCRIP Program!)

#### **Does the percentage that Eastern Tech's PTSA earns come from me or the merchant?**

When you buy SCRIP gift cards a percentage is donated by the gift card merchant. For example, if you buy a \$25 Buffalo Wild Wings gift card, you pay \$25 and the card you receive is worth the full \$25. The additional 8% is donated by Buffalo Wild Wings to Eastern Tech's PTSA.

Credit card transactions may cost as much as 3% of the purchase. To ensure a donation is created with each purchase, SCRIP cannot accept credit cards as a form of payment. Paying by check allows SCRIP to save the transaction fees credit cards charge and pass the savings on to Eastern Tech's PTSA.
