GO MAVERICKS!!

From the Principal . . .

Welcome to the start of a new school year! We want to give a special welcome and congratulations to the members of our Class of 2018 and wish them the best for a successful introduction to high school. As you know, Eastern Technical High School is one of the best high schools in the U. S. In the most recent release by *The Daily Beast* we were named as the #1 high school in Baltimore County of eight high schools meeting their criteria. This year, *The Daily Beast* invited more than 1,200 public high schools with graduation rates of at least 85 percent to complete surveys on student data. To determine this year's top high schools, the online news source compared the schools' four-year cohort graduation rates, college acceptance rates, Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) participation rates and college-entrance exam scores. The 2014 list reflects an emphasis on graduation and college acceptance rates, with these rates weighted most heavily among the considered indicators. Listed in rank order, the following Baltimore County high schools made the "top 15 in Maryland" list:

Eastern Technical High School

George Washington Carver Center for Arts and Technology

Hereford High School

Western School of Technology and Environmental Science

Loch Raven High School

Towson High School

Perry Hall High School

Catonsville High School

We have high expectations for all of our students to help us keep our strong, positive reputation in place. Welcome back!

This is a year of numerous transformations for our teachers and students. The most obvious of these is the move to create an eight (8) credit/four (4) period day schedule. This led us directly into changing our lunch schedule to the new MAV Time opportunity for all students. We will be using the services of a new STAT teacher to assist our teachers with their professional development on numerous topics, including instructional use of technology. We are continuing our implementation of the College and Career Readiness Standards in all of our classes. Each of our teachers has their new HP Revolve device and we have transitioned from Edline to the new BCPS One, Engrade, and SharpSchool as resources for teachers, parents, and students. We expect our students and parents to enjoy the new features and the opportunity to remain current with academic progress throughout the year.

As per the Maryland State Department of Education, "Maryland is striving to create a world-class education system that prepares all students for college and career success in the 21st century. To achieve this, the State has adopted rigorous, internationally benchmarked academic standards and is implementing a new State curriculum and next generation assessments aligned to those standards." The initial testing for the new curriculum began last year and our school helped to pilot the new PARCC Geometry test. This year our students will be taking the PARCC Algebra I (if they haven't yet taken and passed the Alg. I H.S. A.), PARCC Algebra 2 and English 10 PARCC. These exams will eventually be replacing the H.S.A.s as graduation requirements; however, new cut scores still need to be determined prior to doing so. Students will continue to take the Biology H.S.A. and the Government H.S.A. as graduation requirements.

As the school year continues, we'll be providing additional information to students and parents regarding each of the instructional shifts and other information regarding our academic program. Have a great school year!

WHAT IS SCRIPS?

SCRIPS is another name for gift cards. Each gift card you purchase has a specific amount of money that the merchant donates to the Eastern Technical High School PTSA. Cards are available for gas, restaurants, clothes, groceries, Amazon and Groupon purchases. Many places you already shop!! Wal-Mart, Sam's Club and Giant Foods are examples of the most popular cards with many places available.

Gift cards make great gifts and can be purchased through this program. A complete list of gift cards is available by going to www.glscrip.com This program is a service to Eastern Tech families. Payment must be made with the order.

WHAT MAKES BUYING SCRIPS SO GREAT??

- *Purchase gas cards for that new driver so they're never without gas.

SCRIP Gift Cards Frequently Asked Questions - and Answers!

How does buying gift cards from SCRIPS help Eastern Tech?

When you buy SCRIP gift cards, a percentage is donated from the merchant to Eastern Tech PTSA.

Are SCRIP cards the same as gift cards you can purchase at the store?

Yes! They look the same and can be used in exactly the same way.

Where does the percentage that Eastern Tech earns come from?

The merchant donates a percentage to Eastern Tech. You pay \$25 and get a \$25 gift card. You pay \$10 and get a \$10 gift card. Whatever amount you choose to buy, you get the full face value. **There are NO additional fees.**

How can I buy SCRIPS gift cards?

Return a completed order form (attached) and your cash or check payment in an envelope marked SCRIPS to the PTSA mailbox in the main office. The first order is due September 30, 2014.

Why can't I pay with my credit card?

SCRIPS does not accept credit cards, By paying with cash or check, SCRIPS saves on credit card transaction fees and passes the savings on to the Eastern Tech HS PTSA.

When (and how) will I receive my purchased gift cards?

Approximately 1 week after the order deadline, the cards will be placed in an envelope and put in the mailbox of your student's homeroom teacher UNLESS you indicate on your order form not to. In that case, you will be contacted using the information you provide to arrange for pickup.

PLEASE give SCRIPS a try! For the holidays don't waste your gas driving from store to store. Let SCRIPS do the work for you and you will have more time to spend doing the things you enjoy.

Nominating Committee – 3 members needed to nominate PTSA members for positions.

Nominating Committee Procedures:

- 1) There should be a nominating committee of 3 members who shall be elected by the Board of Directors. The committee shall elect its own chair. This committee should be elected at least 2 months prior to the election of officers.
- 2) The election must be held in May during a general membership meeting.
- 3) The nominating committee shall nominate an eligible person for each office.
- 4) A notice should be sent to the general PTSA members stating the date of the election and the list of those nominated as well as asking if there are any additional PTSA members who would like to be nominated for a position. This should be done six weeks prior to the election with a cut-off date for nominations at three weeks prior to the election.
- 5) You will need to review all nominees to be sure they are paid members of the PTSA.
- 6) Once you have the final list of nominees, another note should go out to the PTSA members at least 10 days in advance listing all of the nominees and the date of the election. The election is normally held at 6:30 pm and the general meeting begins at 7:00 pm. All votes must be in person (no e-mail allowed).
- 7) If there is only one person nominated for each position, a verbal vote can be done.

Parent Portal FAQs

1. What is *BCPS One*?

BCPS One is a key initiative that will provide a fully integrated system that brings together all of the district's programs and initiatives around student data, assessments, curriculum, instruction, reporting and analysis into a single user-friendly platform. Through *BCPS One*, educators are also able to communicate classroom level information to students and parents.

2. How do I get access the parent portal of *BCPS One*?

You must first create a myBCPS account and add a student. You will need the parent verification code to complete this process. There are two parts to this process:

Part 1: Create a myBCPS account (one time only)

- a. Go to bcpsone.bcps.org.
- b. Click the "Create a Parent Account" link.
- c. Complete all of the fields on the form and then click the "Create Account" button. An Account Activation Code will be sent to the e-mail address you entered in the form.
- d. Check your e-mail for the Account Activation Code.
- e. Click the link in the e-mail to activate your myBCPS account.
- f. Enter your e-mail address in the e-mail address field.
- g. Enter the Security Code in the "Security Code" field.
- h. Click the "Verify Account" button to activate your account.
- i. Login to your activated myBCPS account and proceed to Part 2.

Part 2: Add a student to your activated myBCPS Account (repeat for each child)

- j. Upon successfully logging in with your myBCPS account, click the "Add A Student" button.
- k. Enter your parent verification code, your student's date of birth and click "Submit."
- l. Click the link to sign into BCPS One.

3. I'm a BCPS employee and a parent/guardian. How would I gain access to my student's information in addition to my BCPS materials?

Use your BCPS credentials to login into <https://www.bcps.org/apps/myBCPS>. From your profile page, you may add your student (see part 2 above).





4. Where do I find the parent verification code?

Schools distributed a printout at the beginning of the school year containing the parent verification code and instructions on how to register. Please contact your student's school if you are missing the parent verification code.

5. I am having trouble seeing my student's information.

Please check the following:

- Did you activate the account by entering the account activation code that was sent to your email address?
- Did you add your student by entering the parent verification code?
- Has the parent verification code expired?

After reviewing the above questions and confirming that the correct date of birth and parent verification code you entered is accurate, contact your student's school to resolve the issue.

6. I am registered and have added a student but I cannot see my student's grades.

Grades are made available as teachers post grades. For more information about your school's grade posting guidelines, contact your school.

7. How do I create a new email account to access BCPS One?

Naviance is up and running at ET. Seniors are actively using Naviance as another resource to assist with the college search and application process and to actually complete college applications. School Counselors have met with each 10th, 11th and 12th grader, providing them an opportunity to access Naviance. Utilization of Naviance actually began last year and will continue this year for all grades 9-12.

In order to encourage more students to actively utilize Naviance the School Counseling office has posted the College representative visitation schedule on Naviance under the "Colleges" tab. Any junior/ senior interested in meeting with college representative at Eastern Tech should sign up for the college visit through NAVIANCE (<http://connection.naviance.com/easternths>). Each junior/senior may sign up for up to 3 college rep visits.

Since some student accounts have been inactive for the entire summer students may need to reset their user name and password. The reset process is easy and can be managed in the ET counseling office. Students can stop by to reset username and password during MAV time.

Parents will have access to Naviance this year as well, with Senior parents receiving their Naviance account codes first. Naviance codes for Parents of Seniors will be distributed on September 18 during our Senior College Information Night. At this event, the ET counseling department will present important information about the college application process. Every senior parent is encouraged to attend Senior College Information Night on September 18, 2014 from 6:30 - 8 in the ET Cafeteria.

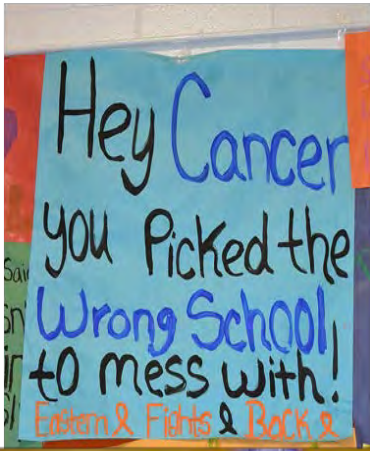

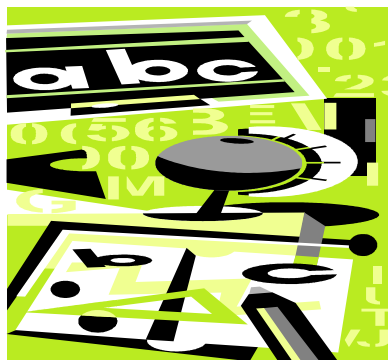
